

EXPERT TESTIMONY: ASBESTOS EXPOSURE

Background

Asbestos litigation is the longest, most expensive mass tort in U.S. history, involving more than 8,000 defendants and 700,000 claimants. Current data indicate that the rate of asbestos claims will increase throughout the next decade.

Our Approach

Patrick Rafferty has been retained as an expert witness in multiple lawsuits filed in Philadelphia Court by claimants with asbestos-related diseases. These cases include people who worked as insulators, pipe-fitters, steam-fitters, mechanics, and others who worked on or around asbestos-containing materials (ACM).
